The following terms and conditions are hereby expressly incorporated into this permit to operate:

Condition 1

The above described air contaminant source is now operating, and over the period covered by the permit will be operated, in full compliance with all applicable state and federal laws and regulations.

Condition 2

Prior to any physical change in, or change in the method of operation of, this air contaminant source which increases the amount of any air pollutant emitted, or results in the emission of any air pollutant not previously emitted, a permit to install must be granted by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (See Chapter 3745-31 of the Ohio Administrative Code).

Condition 3

The Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, or his authorized representative, may enter upon the premises of the source operation at any reasonable time and subject to safety requirements of the person in control of the premises for the purpose of making inspections, conducting tests, examining records or reports pertaining to any emission of air contaminants and determining compliance with all applicable State and Federal air pollution laws and regulations and the terms and conditions of this permit.

Condition 4 (This condition applicable if checked:)

Upon declaration of an Air Pollution Alert, Warning or Emergency Episode this air contaminant source will follow those emission reduction procedures enumerated in the Emergency Action Plan approved by the Director for this source.

Condition 5

This permit to operate shall be effective until 02/01/88. You will be contacted approximately six months prior to this date regarding the renewal of this permit. If you are not contacted, please write to this agency.

Condition 6

A permit fee in the amount specified above must be remitted within fifteen (15) days of the effective date of this permit.

Condition 7

Any transferee of this permit shall, personally, assume the responsibilities of the original permit holder-transferor. The Ohio EPA must be notified in writing of any transfer of this permit.

Condition 8 (This condition is applicable if checked:)

This permit is subject to the supplementary conditions attached.

Indicated below are the incremental steps, or milestones, which will be taken by the air contaminant source described above and the time required to complete each step as well as the time required for the total program. This time schedule is a part of the terms and conditions of the Permit to Operate or Variance for this source and is designed to achieve compliance with either 1) the following rules of the Ohio Administrative Code: 3745-21-09 (D) or 2) the emission limits or requirements established in the Special Terms and Conditions of the variance for this source.

A written report which indicates your progress in completing the required milestone is to be forwarded to the appropriate District Office or Local Air Pollution Control Agency of the Ohio EPA no later than two (2) weeks after each milestone date.

MILESTONE DATES

- 1. Submit final control plan by 9/16/84
- 2. Award contracts for emission control systems or process modifications; or, issue orders for the purchase of component parts to accomplish emission control or process modification by 1/30/85
- 3. Initiate on-site construction or installation of emission control equipment or process change by 8/30/85
- 4. Complete on-site construction or installation of emission control equipment or process change by 11/30/85
- 5. Achieve final compliance by 12/31/85

SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The following rules of the Ohio Administrative Code establish the applicable emission limitations and/or control requirements of this source:

3745-21-09 (D)

(This condition in no way limits the applicability of other requirements of the Ohio Administrative Code to this source.)

2. Record-keeping and reporting requirements for surface coating lines:

This facility shall submit quarterly reports to the Canton Air Pollution Control Agency which lists the following information for each surface coating used with this source:

- (a) the company identification of the surface coating;
- (b) the number of gallons employed;
- (c) the VOC content, in pounds of VOC per gallon of coating;
- (d) the VOC content, in pounds of VOC per gallon of coating; minus water;
- (e) the water content, in percent by volume; and
- (f) the nonvolatile (solids) content, in percent by volume.

These quarterly records, as well as any supporting coating analyses and computations, shall be retained in the company's files for a period of not less than two years and shall be made available to the Director or any authorized representative of the Director for review during normal business hours.
