Enclosed is an Air Contaminant Source Energy Emergency Suspension(s) and Variance(s) to Operate the described air contaminant source(s) without pollution control measures during declared energy emergencies. The enclosed document(s) is in part an action(s) of the Governor and in part an action(s) of the Director of Environmental Protection. Because this document(s) contains several conditions and restrictions, I urge you to read them carefully.

You are hereby notified that the action(s) of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Board of Review pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The action of the Governor is not appealable to the Environmental Board of Review. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. It must be filed with the Environmental Board of Review within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. A copy of the appeal must be served on the Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the Environmental Law Division of the Office of the Attorney General within three (3) days of filing with the Board. An appeal may be filed with the Environmental Board of Review at the following address:

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AIR CONTAMINANT SOURCE ENERGY EMERGENCY  
SUSPENSION AND VARIANCE TO OPERATE

This document is issued to: Canton Drop Forging & Mfg. Co.  
4575 Southway St SW  
Canton, Ohio 44706

and constitutes a suspension of air contaminant emission control requirements relative to, and an energy emergency variance to operate for:

Boilers

This document authorizes the above-described air contaminant source to operate without pollution control measures during declared energy emergencies between the effective date and the expiration date specified herein. Such authorization is given by the State of Ohio in the following manner:

- (A) An emergency suspension by the Governor pursuant to the provisions of Section 110(f) of the Clean Air Act [42 U.S.C. Section 7410(f), 91 Stat. 691 (1977)] of the State adopted implementation plan requirements specified herein based on the fact that the Governor finds that there exists in the vicinity of the above-described air contaminant source a temporary energy emergency involving high levels of unemployment or loss of necessary energy supplies for residential dwellings, and such unemployment or loss can be totally or partially alleviated by this emergency suspension; and
- (B) An emergency suspension by the Governor pursuant to Orders of the Governor in a declared energy emergency under the authority of Section 1551.09 of the Revised Code of the State air pollution control requirements specified herein; and
- (C) An energy emergency Variance to Operate of the Director of Environmental Protection pursuant to emergency rule OAC 3745-35-03(I) from the State air pollution control requirements specified herein.

The following terms and conditions are expressly incorporated into this air contaminant suspension and variance to operate:

Condition I

This variance and suspension shall expire on the date that the declared energy emergency under which this document is issued terminates.

Condition II

This variance and suspension apply to the following rules of the Ohio EPA:

OAC 3745-17-07 (AP-3-07), 3745-17-10 (AP-3-11) and 3745-17-13 (AP-3-14)

Condition III

The source shall reinstate control measures as soon as technically feasible after acquisition of necessary energy supplies.

Condition IV

The source shall, at the request of the Director of Environmental Protection, reinstate pollution control measures during periods in which the Director determines that air pollution levels constitute a danger to public health.

Condition V

The source shall immediately notify the appropriate Ohio EPA District Office or Local Air Pollution Control Agency when pollution control measures are terminated.

Condition VI

Except as specifically authorized by this document, the source shall at all times operate in compliance with all other permits, variances, or compliance orders issued to the source or facility by the Director of Environmental Protection.

Condition VII

The source shall keep accurate records listing the periods in which pollution controls are terminated and the amount and type of air contaminants that are emitted during such periods. Such records shall be provided to the Director of Environmental Protection at his, or his authorized representative's, request.

Condition VIII

The Director of Environmental Protection, or his authorized representative, may enter upon the premises of the source operation at any reasonable time subject to safety requirements of the person in control of the premises for the purpose of making inspections, conducting tests, and determining compliance with all applicable State and Federal air pollution laws and regulations and the terms and conditions of this document.

Condition IX

The source owner shall immediately implement all available alternative operating procedures and interim control measures that will reduce the emissions of the source and reduce the impact of the source on public health.


