This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. 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**Part II - Special Terms and Conditions**

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

**B. Operational Restrictions**

1. None

**C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements**

1. The permittee shall collect and record the following information for each day:
  - a. The company identification for each coating produced.
  - b. The number of hours taken to produce each coating.
  - c. The total organic compound emission rate for all coatings produced, in pounds per day. See Section E.2.

**D. Reporting Requirements**

1. The permittee shall submit a deviation (excursion) report to the Ohio EPA Southeast District Office if any record, as required by section C.1 of these terms and conditions, shows an exceedance of the VOC allowable emissions rates of 8 lbs/hr or 40 lbs/day. The report, including the actual organic compound emissions for each such hour or day, shall be submitted within 30 days following the end of the calendar month in which the deviation occurred.

**E. Testing Requirements**

1. Emission testing has demonstrated that the actual hourly organic compound emission rate at maximum operation is less than half of the allowable limit of 8 lbs organic compounds/hour. Therefore, no additional monitoring or record keeping is necessary to demonstrate compliance with this limit.
2. Compliance with the daily organic compound emission limit shall be based upon the record keeping requirements contained in Section C.1 of this permit.

Emissions shall be calculated using the following emission factors for organic compounds (OC) which were developed by emission testing performed at the facility and include cleanup emissions:  
 Products using 1 disperser mixer and no sandmill: 0.1875 pound OC per hour;  
 Products using 1 disperser mixer and 1 sandmill: 2.8125 pounds OC per hour; and  
 Products using 2 disperser mixers and 1 sandmill: 3.000 pounds OC per hour.

Emissions shall be calculated by multiplying the appropriate emission factor for the batch by the number of hours taken to process that batch. The emissions for all batches produced in a given day shall be added together to determine the total daily OC emission rate.
