This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. 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Part II - Special Terms and Conditions

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

B. Operational Restrictions

1. None

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. The permittee shall maintain the following:
 - a. Monthly records of the total organic compound concentration in the water, as measured at the inlet to the air stripper. A minimum of one sample shall be analyzed per month;
 - b. Daily records of the water flow rate through the air stripper; and
 - c. Daily records of the organic compound emission rate, calculated in accordance with Section E.1.

D. Reporting Requirements

1. Quarterly reports shall be submitted to the Ohio EPA Southeast District Office summarizing the information in Section C.1 and shall include the year-to-date total OC emissions, in tons. The reports shall be submitted by January 15, April 15, July 15 and October 15 and shall cover the previous calendar quarter.

E. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with the daily organic compound emission limit shall be determined by multiplying the most recently measured total organic compound concentration by the daily flow rate.
2. Compliance with the allowable annual organic compound emission limit shall be based on the sum of all the daily emission rates for the calendar year.
