This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

2. **Additional Terms and Conditions**
 - (a) The emission limits established pursuant to OAC rule 3745-31-05 represent maximum potential emissions based on 8760 hours per year of operation. Therefore, no monitoring of natural gas usage is necessary to demonstrate compliance with these emission limits.

E. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with the emission limits in Section A.1 shall be based on the emission factors from AP-42, Fifth Edition, Table 3.2-4 or through emission testing performed in accordance with the appropriate Reference Method from 40 CFR Part 60, Appendix A. No emission testing is specifically required to demonstrate compliance with these emission limits but, if appropriate, may be requested pursuant to OAC rule 3745-15-04 (A).
2. Compliance with the visible emission limit shall be determined in accordance with OAC rule 3745-17-03.
