This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. 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Part II - Special Terms and Conditions

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

1. For the purpose of a permit-to-install document, the emissions unit terms and conditions identified below are federally enforceable with the exception of those listed below which are enforceable under state law only.

A. Applicable Emissions Limitations and/or Control Requirements

1. The specific operation(s), property, and/or equipment which constitute this emissions unit are listed in the following table along with the applicable rules and/or requirements and with the applicable emissions limitations and/or control measures. Emissions from this unit shall not exceed the listed limitations, and the listed control measures shall be employed. Additional applicable emissions limitations and/or control measures (if any) may be specified in narrative form following the table.

2. Additional Terms and Conditions

- (a) The 3.1 lbs of PM/hr limitation was established for PTI purposes to reflect the potential to emit for this emissions unit. Therefore, it is not necessary to develop record keeping and/or reporting requirements to ensure compliance with this limit.

B. Operational Restrictions

1. The permittee shall employ a fabric filter having a design control efficiency for particulates greater than 99% during any operation of the emissions unit.

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. This permittee shall maintain monthly records of the following:
 - a. The company identification of each product extruded;
 - b. the amount of each product extruded during the calendar month, in lbs;
 - c. the VOC content of each product, in lb(s) of VOC/lb(s) of product;
 - d. the total number of hours each product was extruded during the calendar month;
 - e. the average hourly VOC emission rate, in lbs/hr, for each product (i.e., (b)x(c)/d); and
 - f. the average hourly VOC emission rate, in lbs/hr, for all products (i.e., the sum of (e) for all products divided by the number of products).

D. Reporting Requirements

1. The permittee shall submit deviation (excursion) reports of any monthly record which shows that the average hourly VOC emission rate exceeded 7.3 lbs of VOC/hr, and the actual average hourly VOC emission rate for the month. The notification shall include a copy of such record and shall be sent to the Ohio EPA, Southeast District Office within 45 days after the end of the month during which the exceedance occurs.

E. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with the emission limitation of 7.3 lbs of VOC/hr shall be based on the record keeping specified in Section C.1.f of this permit.
2. If required, compliance with the particulate matter emission limit shall be determined in accordance with 40 CFR Part 60, Appendix A, Methods 1-5 and the procedures specified in OAC rule 3745-17-03.

F. Miscellaneous Requirements

1. The following terms and conditions shall supersede all the air pollution control requirements contained in permit to install number 06-2400 issued for this emissions unit on April 19, 1989:
