
The Ohio EPA has received a request for a modification for the Ohio EPA Permit to Install referenced above.

APPLICABILITY

This Permit to Install is applicable only to the air contaminant sources listed and does not include the installation or modification of wastewater disposal systems or solid waste disposal facilities. Separate application must be made to the Director for the installation or modification of any such wastewater disposal systems or solid waste disposal facilities.

PUBLIC DISCLOSURE

The facility is hereby notified that this permit, and all agency records concerning the operation of this permitted source are subject to public disclosure in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-49-03.

MALFUNCTION/ABATEMENT

This source and its associated air pollution control system(s) shall be maintained regularly in accordance with good engineering practices and the recommendations of the respective manufacturers in order to minimize air contaminant emissions.

In accordance with OAC Rule 3745-15-06, any malfunction of the source(s) or associated air pollution control system(s) shall be reported immediately to the Toledo Environmental Services Division, 26 Main St., Toledo, Ohio 43605. Except as provided by OAC Rule 3745-15-06(A)(3), scheduled maintenance of air pollution control equipment, that requires the shutdown or bypassing of said equipment, must be accompanied by the shutdown of the associated air pollution sources.

The maximum throughput for this source shall be 3,000,000 gallons per calendar year.
