This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. **B. Operational Restrictions**

**C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements**

1. The permittee shall collect and record the following information each day for this emissions unit:
  - a. The name and identification of each lubricant.
  - b. The number of gallons of each lubricant employed.
  - c. The volatile organic compound (VOC) content of each lubricant, in percent by volume.
  - d. The total OC emissions from all lubricants employed, in pounds per day.
  - e. The total number of hours the emissions unit was in operation.
  - f. The average hourly organic compound emission rate for all lubricants, i.e., (d)/(e) in pounds per hour.

**D. Reporting Requirements**

1. In accordance with paragraph 3 of the General Terms and Conditions, the permittee shall submit quarterly deviation (excursion) reports which include the following information:
  - a. An identification of each day during which the average organic compound emission rate from this emissions unit exceeded 8.0 pounds per hour, and the actual average organic compound emissions for each such day.
  - b. An identification of each day during which the organic compound emission rate from this emissions unit exceeded 15.1 pounds per day, and the actual organic compound emissions for each such day.

**E. Testing Requirements**

1. Compliance with the emission limitation(s) in Section A.1 of these terms and conditions shall be determined in accordance with the following method(s):

organic compound emission rates for the calendar year divided by 2,000 lbs/ton.
