This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. 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Part II - Special Terms and Conditions

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

2. **Additional Terms and Conditions**
 - (a) The 1.12 lbs VOC/hr limit was established for PTI purposes to reflect the potential to emit for this emissions unit. Therefore, it is not necessary to develop record keeping and reporting requirements to ensure compliance with this limit.

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. The permittee shall collect and record the following information each month for the line:
 - a. The name and identification number of each ink, as applied.
 - b. The VOC content of each ink (excluding water and exempt solvents), as applied.
 - c. The number of gallons (excluding water and exempt solvents) of each ink employed.
 - d. The total VOC emissions from all ink materials employed, in pounds or tons per month.

D. Reporting Requirements

1. The permittee shall notify the Director in writing of any monthly record showing a total VOC emissions from all inks greater than 0.23 tons. This notification shall include a copy of such record and shall be sent to the Director within 30 days following the end of the calendar month.

E. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with the emission limitation(s) in section A.1. of these terms and conditions shall be determined in accordance with the following method(s):
 Formulation data or USEPA Method 24 shall be used to determine the organic compound contents of the coatings.
 Emission Limitation -
 0.23 tons per month VOC

 Applicable Compliance Method -
 Compliance shall be based upon the record keeping specified in (C)(1).
 Emission Limitation -
 2.80 TPY VOC

 Applicable Compliance Method -
 Compliance shall be based upon the record keeping specified in (C)(1) and shall be the sum of the 12 monthly VOC emission rates for the calendar year.
