Compliance with the emission limitation(s) in section A.1 of these terms and conditions shall be determined in accordance with the following method(s):

8.54 lbs/hr of particulates

Applicable Compliance Method-
Compliance may be determined by multiplying the maximum hourly production rate of 240 tons/hr by the AP-42 emission factor, 0.27 lb/ton. The resulting uncontrolled emission rate, 64.8 lbs/hr, is then multiplied by a fabric filter control factor of 99% (1-.99), resulting un a controlled emission rate of 0.648 lb/hr. If required by Ohio EPA, emission tests whall be performed in accordance with USEPA Methods 1-5 to demonstrate compliance with the allowable emission rate.
