This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. 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Part II - Special Terms and Conditions

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

1. For the purpose of a permit-to-install document, the emissions unit terms and conditions identified below are federally enforceable with the exception of those listed below which are enforceable under state law only.

A. Applicable Emissions Limitations and/or Control Requirements

1. 2. **Additional Terms and Conditions**
 - (a) The 3.6 lbs/hour OC emission limit was established for PTI purposes to reflect the potential to emit for this emissions unit. Therefore, it is not necessary to develop record keeping and/or reporting requirements to ensure compliance with this limit.

B. Operational Restrictions

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. The permittee shall collect and record the following information each month for the coating mixing operation:
 - a. The company identification for each coating mixed.
 - b. The number of gallons of each coating mixed.
 - c. The OC content of each coating mixed, in pounds per gallon.
 - d. The OC emission rate for all coatings mixed, in pounds.
 - e. The total number of days the emissions unit was in operation.
 - f. The average daily OC emission rate for all coatings mixed, (d)/(e), in pounds per day (average).

D. Reporting Requirements

1. The permittee shall submit deviation (excursion) reports which include an identification of each day during which the average daily organic compound emissions from the coating mixing operation exceeded 40 pounds per day, and the actual average daily organic compound emissions for each such month.

These quarterly deviation (excursion) reports shall be submitted to the Director (the appropriate District Office or local air agency) by January 31, April 30, July 31, and October 31 of each year and shall cover the previous calendar quarter. If no deviations occurred during the calendar quarter, the permittee shall submit a report which states that no deviations occurred during the calendar quarter.

E. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with the emission limitation(s) in Section A.1. of these terms and conditions shall be determined in accordance with the following method(s):

Emission Limitation -
3.6 lbs/hour OC

Applicable Compliance Method -

Compliance shall be determined by multiplying the maximum hourly coating mixing rate, in tons, by the AP-42 Table 6.4-1 (1/95) emission factor for coating mixing of 30 lbs OC/ton of product.

Emission Limitation -
40 lbs/day OC

Applicable Compliance Method -

Compliance shall be based upon record keeping as specified in C.1.

Emission Limitation -
0.406 TPY OC

Applicable Compliance Method -

Compliance shall be based upon record keeping as specified in C.1. and shall be determined by summing the twelve monthly OC emission rates for the calendar year and dividing by 2,000 pounds per ton.
