This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. 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Part II - Special Terms and Conditions

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

1. For the purpose of a permit-to-install document, the emissions unit terms and conditions identified below are federally enforceable with the exception of those listed below which are enforceable under state law only.

A. Applicable Emissions Limitations and/or Control Requirements

1. 2. **Additional Terms and Conditions**
 - (a) The use of photochemically reactive materials, as defined in OAC rule 3745-21-01(C)(5), in this emissions unit is prohibited.

B. Operational Restrictions

1. The maximum annual operating rate for this emissions unit shall not exceed 6,000 hours per year.

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. The permittee shall collect and record the following information each month for this emissions unit:
 - a. The name and company identification of each solvent material employed.
 - b. The total solvent material usage, in pounds.
 - c. The decimal fraction of organic compounds, by weight, in each solvent material employed.
 - d. The total monthly OC emission rate for all solvent materials employed, in tons [i.e., the summation of (b x c) for all solvents, divided by 2000 lbs/ton].
 - e. The total number of hours the emissions unit was in operation.
 - f. Whether or not each solvent material employed is a photochemically reactive material.

D. Reporting Requirements

1. The permittee shall submit quarterly deviation (excursion) reports, in accordance with Section 3. of the General Terms and Conditions of this permit, that include the following information:
 - a. An identification of each month during which the monthly OC emission rate exceeded 2.15 tons per month, and the actual OC emission rate for each such month.
 - b. An identification of each month during which photochemically reactive materials were employed in this emissions unit.
2. The permittee shall submit annual reports that specify the total hours of operation and the total organic compound emissions for this emissions unit for the previous calendar year. These reports shall be submitted by January 31 of each year.

E. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with the emission limitations in Section A.1. of these terms and conditions shall be determined in accordance with the following methods:
Emission Limitation-

2.15 tons OC/month

Applicable Compliance Method-
Compliance shall be determined by recordkeeping as specified in Section C.1. of this permit.
Emission Limitation-
25.80 TPY OC

Applicable Compliance Method-
Compliance shall be determined by recordkeeping as specified in Section C.1. of this permit and shall be the sum of the monthly OC emissions for the calendar year.
Operational Limitation-
maximum annual operating rate shall not exceed 6,000 hours per year

Applicable Compliance Method-
Compliance shall be based on recordkeeping as specified in Section C.1. of this permit.
