The Ohio EPA has received a request for a modification for the Ohio EPA Permit to Install referenced above.


The Permit to Install issued to Hoover Company-Plant I (PTI No. 15-1206) is hereby modified in the following manner:

The reason for the modification is: to correct the Air Emissions Summary on Page 4 and Additional Special Terms and Conditions on Pages 6 and 7 of PTI No. 15-1206 issued December 20, 1995, due to an administrative error.

vinyl toluene is a non-HAP. This Permit to Install will replace Permit to Install 15-417 and 15-670 for sources K004 and K005 respectively. K006 did not previously have a Permit to Install.

2. Operational and/or Production Limitations:

This facility will limit the polyester resin usage to each emission unit as follows:

K004	.450 gal/hr 217 gal/month
K005	.325 gal/hr 183 gal/month
K006	.480 gal/hr 80 gal/month

3. Federal Enforceable Limitations on Potential to Emit:

The following Terms and Conditions are federally enforceable and incorporated into this Permit to Install to limit the potential to emit for these emission units:

4. Record-Keeping Requirements:

This facility shall maintain monthly records which list the following information for each surface coating employed in sources K004, K005 and K006:

- a. the company identification of the surface coating;
- b. the number of gallons employed;
- c. the VOC content, in pounds of VOC per gallon of coating;
- d. the VOC content, in pounds of VOC per gallon of coating; minus water;
- e. the water content, in percent by volume;
- f. the nonvolatile (solids) content, in percent by volume;
- g. the type and amount of clean-up solvent employed; and
- h. type and amount of solvent used to maintain the viscosity of the coating.

These monthly records, as well as any supporting coating analyses and computations, shall be retained in the company's files for a period of not less than two years and shall be made available to the Director or any authorized representative of the Director for review. Copies of these records will be made available upon request.

5. Reporting Requirements:

This facility shall submit semi-annual reports to the Canton City Health Department, Air Pollution Control Division, 420 Market Avenue N., Canton, Ohio 44702, Phone (216)489-3385, which summarize the following information for each coating employed in these sources (K004, K005 and K006) during the previous six calendar months: coating identification of the surface coating; the total number of gallons employed; the VOC content in pounds of VOC per gallon of coating; the VOC content (in pounds VOC per gallon of coating, minus water); the water content; the nonvolatile (solids) content; and the type and amount of clean-up solvent employed. The reports shall be submitted by February 15 and August 15 of each year and shall cover the previous six calendar months (July through December and January through June, respectively).
