This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. 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**Part II - Special Terms and Conditions**

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

1. For the purpose of a permit-to-install document, the emissions unit terms and conditions identified below are federally enforceable with the exception of those listed below which are enforceable under state law only.

**A. Applicable Emissions Limitations and/or Control Requirements**

1. **C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements**

1. The permittee shall collect and record the following information each month for the coating operation:
  - a. The company identification for each coating material employed.
  - b. The number of gallons of each coating material employed.
  - c. The organic compound content of each coating material, in pounds per gallon.
  - d. The total organic compound emission rate for all coating materials, in pounds or tons.
  - e. The total number of days the emissions unit was in operation.
  - f. The average daily organic compound emission rate for all coating materials, i.e., (d)/(e), in pounds per day (average).

**D. Reporting Requirements**

1. In accordance with paragraph 3 of the General Terms and Conditions, the permittee shall submit quarterly deviation (excursion) reports to the Director ( the appropriate Ohio EPA District Office or local air agency) which include the following information for this emissions unit:
  - a. An identification of each month during which the daily total OC emission rate exceeds 15 lbs OC for coatings/day, and the actual OC emission rate for the month.
  - b. An identification of each month during which the monthly total OC emission rate exceeds 457 lbs OC for coatings/day, and the actual OC emission rate for the month.

**E. Testing Requirements**

1. Compliance with the emission limitation(s) in Section A.1 of these terms and conditions shall be determined in accordance with the following method(s):  
Emission Limitation-  
15 lbs OC/day

## Applicable Compliance Method-

Compliance shall be based upon the record keeping specified in Section C.1.

## Emission Limitation-

457 lbs OC/month

## Applicable Compliance Method-

Compliance shall be based upon the record keeping specified in Section C.1.

## Emission Limitation-

2.74 tons OC/yr

## Applicable Compliance Method-

Compliance shall be based upon the record keeping specified in Section C.1. and shall be the sum of the 12 monthly OC emission rates for the calendar year.

2. Formulation data or USEPA Method 24 shall be used to determine the organic compound contents of the coatings.

**F. Miscellaneous Requirements**

1. The permittee shall comply with any applicable State and federal requirements governing the storage, treatment, transport, and disposal of any waste material generated by the operation of the sources.
2. The permittee is hereby notified that this permit and all agency records concerning the operation of this permitted emissions unit are subject to public disclosure in accordance with OAC rule 3745-49-03.
3. The following terms and conditions shall supersede all the air pollution control requirements for this emissions unit contained in permit to install # 08-3624, as issued on November 27, 1996: Part II Sections A.1, C.1, D.1, F.1 and F.2.
