This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. 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**Part II - Special Terms and Conditions**

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

1. For the purpose of a permit-to-install document, the emissions unit terms and conditions identified below are federally enforceable with the exception of those listed below which are enforceable under state law only.

**A. Applicable Emissions Limitations and/or Control Requirements**

1. The specific operation(s), property, and/or equipment which constitute this emissions unit are listed in the following table along with the applicable rules and/or requirements and with the applicable emissions limitations and/or control measures. Emissions from this unit shall not exceed the listed limitations, and the listed control measures shall be employed. Additional applicable emissions limitations and/or control measures (if any) may be specified in narrative form following the table.

**2. Additional Terms and Conditions**

- (a) The 16.5 lbs/hr limit was established to reflect the potential to emit for the emission unit. Therefore it is not necessary to develop record keeping and reporting requirements to ensure compliance with this limit.

**B. Operational Restrictions**

1. The maximum daily throughput for this emissions unit shall not exceed 40,000 gallons.
2. The maximum annual throughput for this emissions unit shall not exceed 660,000 gallons.
3. All material loading by this emissions unit shall be through the use of submerged filling.

**C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements**

1. The permittee shall record the total throughput each day for the emissions unit.

**D. Reporting Requirements**

1. The permittee shall submit deviation (excursion) reports which identify each day during which the daily throughput exceeded 40,000 gallons, and the actual daily throughput for each such day. The notification shall include a copy of such record and shall be sent to the Director (the appropriate District Office or local air agency) within 45 days after the deviation occurs.
2. The permittee shall also submit annual reports which specify the total throughput from this emissions unit for the previous calendar year. These reports shall be submitted by January 31 of each year.

**E. Testing Requirements**

1. Compliance with the emission limitations in section A.1 of these terms and conditions shall be determined in accordance with the following methods:  
 Emission Limitation:  
 16.5 lbs/hr of OC  
 Applicable Compliance Method:  
 Compliance shall be determined by multiplying the maximum hourly throughput of 3,300 gallons times 5 lbs/1,000 gallons "AP-42 Fifth Edition, compilation of Air Pollution Emission Factors, Section 5.25."  
 Emission Limitation:  
 1.65 tpy of OC  
 Applicable Compliance Method:

Compliance shall be based upon the record keeping requirement in section C.1, summing the daily throughputs for the calendar year, multiplying the sum times 5 lbs/1,000 gallons "AP-42, Fifth Edition, compilation of Air Pollution Emission Factors, Section 5.2-5", and dividing by 2,000 lbs/ton.

**F. Miscellaneous Requirements**

1. The permittee is hereby notified that this permit, and all agency records concerning the operation of this permitted emissions unit are subject to public disclosure in accordance with OAC rule 3745-49-03.
2. The permittee shall comply with any applicable State and federal requirements governing the storage, treatment, transport, and disposal of any waste material generated by the operation of the emissions unit.
