This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. Part II - Special Terms and Conditions

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

1. For the purpose of a permit-to-install document, the emissions unit terms and conditions identified below are federally enforceable with the exception of those listed below which are enforceable under state law only.

2. For the purpose of a permit-to-operate document, the emissions unit terms and conditions identified below are enforceable under state law only with the exception of those listed below which are federally enforceable.

A. Applicable Emissions Limitations and/or Control Requirements

1. The specific operation(s), property, and/or equipment which constitute this emissions unit are listed in the following table along with the applicable rules and/or requirements and with the applicable emissions limitations and/or control measures. Emissions from this unit shall not exceed the listed limitations, and the listed control measures shall be employed. Additional applicable emissions limitations and/or control measures (if any) may be specified in narrative form following the table.

2. **Additional Terms and Conditions**
 - (a) The 8 lbs OC/hr limit was established for PTI purposes to reflect potential to emit for this emissions unit. Therefore, it is not necessary to develop record keeping and/or reporting requirements to ensure compliance with this limit.

B. Operational Restrictions

1. None

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. The permittee shall collect and record the following information each day for the emissions unit P004, to demonstrate compliance with the allowable organic compound emission rates:
 - a. The company identification for each coating and cleanup material employed;
 - b. The number of gallons of each coating and cleanup material employed;
 - c. The organic compound content of each coating and cleanup material, in pounds per gallon; and
 - d. The total organic compound emission rate for all coatings and cleanup material, in pounds per day.
2. The permittee shall collect and record the following information each day for the emissions unit P004, to demonstrate compliance with the allowable hazardous air pollutant emission rates:
 - a. The company identification for each coating and cleanup material employed;
 - b. The number of gallons of each coating and cleanup material employed;
 - c. The hazardous air pollutant content of each coating and cleanup material, in pounds per gallon; and
 - d. The total hazardous air pollutant emission rate for all coatings and cleanup material, in pounds per day.

D. Reporting Requirements

1. In accordance with paragraph 3 of the General Terms and Conditions, the permittee shall submit quarterly deviation (excursion) reports which include the following information for emissions unit P004:

An identification of each day during which the total organic compound emission rate exceeded 40 pounds per day, and the actual organic compound emission rate for each such day, and an identification of each day during which the total hazardous air pollutant emission rate of 20.64 pounds per day is exceeded and the actual emission rate for each such day.

E. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with the emission limitation(s) in this permit shall be determined in accordance with the following method(s):

Emission Limitation-
8.0 lbs/hr total OC, including total HAPs and cleanup

Applicable Compliance Method-
Compliance can be developed from the record keeping in section C.1 and the actual operating hours of each day.

Emission Limitation-
40 lbs/day total OC, including total HAPs and cleanup

Applicable Compliance Method-
Compliance shall be based upon the record keeping requirements as specified in section C.1.

Emission Limitation-
7.3 TPY total OC, including total HAPs and cleanup

Applicable Compliance Method-
Compliance shall be based upon the record keeping requirements as specified in section C.1., and shall be the sum of the daily OC emission rates for the calendar year.

Emission Limitation-
20.64 lbs/day total HAPs and cleanup

Applicable Compliance Method-
Compliance shall be based upon the record keeping requirements as specified in section C.2.

Emission Limitation-
3.77 TPY total HAPs and cleanup

Applicable Compliance Method-
Compliance shall be based upon the record keeping requirements as specified in section C.2., and shall be the sum of the daily total HAPs emission rates for the calendar year.

F. **Miscellaneous Requirements**

1. The permittee is hereby notified that this permit, and all agency records concerning the operation of this permitted emissions unit are subject to public disclosure in accordance with OAC rule 3745-49-03.
