Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. 2. Additional Terms and Conditions

- (a) The unpaved road segments and parking areas which are covered by this permit and which are subject to the requirements of Paragraph (B) of OAC rule 3745-17-08 are listed in the sections below:

Unpaved parking areas and associated unpaved road segments:

- i. identification: roadways used by customer vehicles and owner's loading equipment and parking lot
- ii. approximate one-way mileage of road segment: 0.5
- iii. approximate surface area (sq. ft.): 40,200

All unpaved parking areas and road segments which are listed in 2.a above shall periodically be treated with water, or any other suitable dust suppressant, in order to minimize or eliminate, at all times, visible emissions of fugitive dust generated by vehicular traffic. Frequency of application shall be as needed. This term and conditions may be waived during wet conditions when there is sufficient moisture to prevent visible emissions of fugitive dust.

The permittee shall post speed limit signs on the unpaved road segments identified in 2.a above. The speed limit for all unpaved roads shall not exceed five (5) miles per hour.

Any material carried off of the owner's property and deposited onto the public roadways by vehicular traffic or any other means shall be promptly removed and disposed of properly in such manner so as to minimize or prevent resuspension.

B. Operational Restrictions

1. Open bodied vehicles transporting materials likely to become airborne shall be covered at all times.

2. Additional Terms and Conditions

- (a) The permittee shall comply with the following measures to eliminate or minimize the visible emissions of fugitive dust resulting from the operation of this emissions unit:
 - i. reduce drop height of front-end loader buckets during load-out operation;
 - ii. water all storage piles, including the surrounding area, and materials being unloaded from ships;
 - iii. maintain each storage pile height as low as possible to reduce wind erosion;
 - iv. keep vehicle speed as slow as possible when driving vehicles around storage piles;
 - v. clean any spilled material as soon as possible; and
 - vi. repair any leaks as soon as possible.

B. Operational Restrictions

- 1. The free fall distance between the ship's boom and the storage pile must not exceed five (5) feet to minimize the visible emission of fugitive dust.
