This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. Part II - Special Terms and Conditions

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

B. Operational Restrictions

1. The permittee shall employ no more than 3 gallons of coating in any one day in this emission unit.
2. The permittee shall operate the dry filters when this emissions unit is in operation.

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. The permittee shall collect and record the following information each day for the coating line:
 - a. The name and identification number of each coating employed.
 - b. The volume, in gallons, of each coating employed.
 - c. The total volume, in gallons, of all of the coatings employed.
2. The permittee shall collect and record the following information each day for this emissions unit:
 - a. whether or not the dry filters were in service when the emissions unit was in operation.

D. Reporting Requirements

1. The permittee shall submit quarterly deviation (excursion) reports that identify all exceedances of the daily coating usage limitation in II.A.1.
2. The permittee shall submit quarterly deviation (excursion) reports that identify all excursions of the requirement to use a dry filter as specified in II.B.2.
3. The quarterly deviation reports shall be submitted in accordance with the General Terms and Conditions of this permit.

E. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with the emission limitations and operational restrictions of these terms and conditions shall be determined in accordance with the following methods:
 - a. Emission Limitation:

Use of no more than 3 gallons of coatings per day.
 - Applicable Compliance Method:

Daily records shall be maintained of the daily usage of all coatings employed.
