

The Permit to Install issued to Allen Oil Company (PTI No. 17-714) is hereby modified in the following manner:


Terms and Conditions on Pages 4 and 5 of Permit to Install issued February 14, 1990.

WASTE DISPOSAL

The owner/operator shall comply with any applicable state and federal requirements governing the storage, treatment, transport and disposal of any waste material generated by the operation of the sources.

MAINTENANCE OF EQUIPMENT

This source and its associated air pollution control system(s) shall be maintained regularly in accordance with good engineering practices and the recommendations of the respective manufacturers in order to minimize air contaminant emissions.

MALFUNCTION/ABATEMENT

In accordance with OAC Rule 3745-15-06, any malfunction of the source(s) or associated air pollution control system(s) shall be reported immediately to the North Ohio Valley Air Authority.

Except as provided by OAC Rule 3745-15-06(A)(3), scheduled maintenance of air pollution control equipment that requires the shutdown or bypassing of air pollution control system(s) must be accompanied by the shutdown of the associated air pollution sources.

MISCELLANEOUS STORAGE TANKS

Unless otherwise indicated, BAT for any miscellaneous storage tanks identified within this permit consists of the use of submerged fill into the storage tanks. The submerged fill pipe(s) are to be installed within six (6) inches of the bottom of the storage tank.

ADDITIONAL SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

This facility shall not process more than an average of 4000 gallons of petroleum per day. This limitation shall be calculated by taking the number of gallons of petroleum processed per 12 month period and dividing it by the total number of days the facility processed gasoline during the same 12 month period. This facility shall report any exceedance of the 4000 gallon/day limit to North Ohio Valley Air Authority within 45 days after the exceedance occurs.
