The Permit to Install issued to Union Camp Corp. (PTI No. 06-2685) is hereby modified in the following manner:


Terms and Conditions on Page 6 of Permit to Install issued March 14, 1990.

NEW SOURCE PERFORMANCE STANDARD SUBPART Kb

The application and enforcement of the provisions of the New Source Performance Standards (NSPS), as promulgated by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, 40 CFR Part 60, are delegated to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency. The requirements of 40 CFR Part 60 are also federally enforceable.

In accordance with 40 CFR 60.116b(a) and (b), the owner and operator of storage vessel T032 shall keep readily accessible records showing the dimension of each storage vessel and an analysis showing the capacity of each storage vessel for the life of each source.
