**SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. Applicable Rules:

The following rules of the Ohio Administrative Code establish the applicable emission limitations and/or control requirements for this source:

3745-31-05 (A)(3)

(This condition in no way limits the applicability of other requirements of the Ohio Administrative Code to this source.)

2. Allowable Mass Emission Limitation(s) and/or Control Requirements:

The mass emissions from this source shall not exceed the following:

Emissions of carbon monoxide shall not exceed 2.8 grams per horsepower-hour or 25.93 pounds per hour or 113.6 tons per year.

Emissions of nitrogen oxides shall not exceed 2.0 grams per horsepower-hour or 18.52 pounds per hour or 81.1 tons per year.

Emissions of volatile organic compounds shall not exceed 0.9 gram per horsepower-hour or 8.33 pounds per hour or 36.5 tons per year.

3. Stack Test Requirements for Carbon Monoxide, Nitrogen Oxides and Volatile Organic Compound Emissions:

Between twelve (12) and six (6) months prior to the expiration of this permit, this facility shall conduct, or have conducted, an emission test(s) for this source in order to demonstrate compliance with the allowable mass emission rate for carbon monoxide, nitrogen oxides and volatile organic compounds.

The emission test(s) shall be conducted in accordance with the test methods and procedures approved by Ohio EPA.

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Not later than 30 days prior to the proposed test date(s), this facility shall submit an "Intent to Test" notification to the Ohio EPA Southeast District Office. The "Intent to Test" notification shall describe in detail the proposed test methods and procedures, the source operating parameters, the time(s) and date(s) of the test(s), and the person(s) who will be conducting the test(s). Failure to submit such notification for review and approval prior to the test(s) may result in the Southeast District Office's refusal to accept the results of the emission test(s).

Personnel from the Ohio EPA Southeast District Office shall be permitted to witness the test(s), examine the testing equipment and acquire data and information regarding the source operating parameters.

A comprehensive written report on the results of the emission test(s) shall be submitted to the Ohio EPA Southeast District Office within 30 days following completion of the test(s).
