This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. 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Part II - Special Terms and Conditions

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

1. For the purpose of a permit-to-install document, the emissions unit terms and conditions identified below are federally enforceable with the exception of those listed below which are enforceable under state law only.

A. Applicable Emissions Limitations and/or Control Requirements

1. The specific operation(s), property, and/or equipment which constitute this emissions unit are listed in the following table along with the applicable rules and/or requirements and with the applicable emissions limitations and/or control measures. Emissions from this unit shall not exceed the listed limitations, and the listed control measures shall be employed. Additional applicable emissions limitations and/or control measures (if any) may be specified in narrative form following the table.

2. **Additional Terms and Conditions**
 - (a) The vapor pressure of any material stored in this emissions unit shall not exceed 2.3 psia.

B. Operational Restrictions

1. The throughput of all materials stored in this emissions unit shall not exceed 2,000,000 gallons/year based on a rolling, 12-month summation.

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. The permittee shall maintain monthly records of the following:
 - a. the name and identification of each material stored in this emissions unit,
 - b. the vapor pressure of each material stored in this emissions unit,
 - c. the total gallons of throughput for each material stored in this emissions unit, and
 - d. the rolling, 12-month summation of the total gallons of throughput for all materials stored in this emissions unit.

D. Reporting Requirements

1. The permittee shall notify the Director in writing of any monthly record which shows an exceedance of the vapor pressure limit and/or the throughput limit. A copy of each such record shall be sent to the Director within 45 days of the exceedance.

E. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with the OC emission limit in section A.1 of this permit shall be demonstrated by the emission factors outlined in AP-42 (Organic Liquid Storage Tanks), the vapor pressure of the material(s) stored, and the annual throughput of material(s) stored in this emissions unit.

F. Miscellaneous Requirements

1. If the permittee plans to store any material in this emissions unit which was not originally identified within the permit to install application, the permittee shall notify the Ohio EPA field office at least fourteen (14) days in advance to determine if a permit modification is required.
2. The following terms and conditions shall supersede all the air pollution control requirements for this emissions unit contained in permit to install number 14-3540 as issued on 4-16-97:
