This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. 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Part II - Special Terms and Conditions

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

B. Operational Restrictions

1. The maximum gasoline throughput for this emissions unit shall not exceed 700 gallons per day and 255,500 gallons per year.

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. The permittee shall maintain records of the daily throughput of gasoline in this emissions unit, in gallons per day.
2. The annual gasoline throughput for this emissions unit shall be determined by summing the daily throughput records specified in Section C.1.

D. Reporting Requirements

1. The permittee shall notify the Hamilton County Department of Environmental Services in writing of any record which shows an exceedance of the daily or annual gasoline throughput limitations specified in Section B.1 of this permit. The notification shall include a copy of such record and shall be sent to the Hamilton County Department of Environmental Services within 30 days after the exceedance occurs.

E. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with the emission limitations specified in Section A.1 shall be determined by the following methods:

Emission Limitations:

Volatile organic compound (VOC) emissions shall not exceed 7.15 pounds per day and 1.30 tons per year (TPY).

Applicable Compliance Method:

Compliance with the emission limitations shall be demonstrated by compliance with the gasoline throughput limitations in Section B.1. Daily and annual emissions may be determined by using the loading operations uncontrolled emission factor found in US EPA AP-42 Section 5.2, Table 5.2-5 (1/1995), of 5 pounds of organic emissions per 1000 gallons of gasoline throughput, and multiplying this emissions factor by the actual daily and annual gasoline throughput records specified in Sections C.1. and C.2.

2. Compliance with the operational restrictions in Section B.1 for gasoline throughput shall be determined by the record keeping requirements specified in Sections C.1 and C.2.
