This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. 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Part II - Special Terms and Conditions

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

1. For the purpose of a permit-to-install document, the emissions unit terms and conditions identified below are federally enforceable with the exception of those listed below which are enforceable under state law only.

A. Applicable Emissions Limitations and/or Control Requirements

1. 2. Additional Terms and Conditions

- (a) The VOC content (as applied) of each coating employed in this emissions unit shall not exceed 6.73 pounds per gallon.

B. Operational Restrictions

1. The coating usage (as applied) for this emissions unit shall not exceed 8 gallons per day and 600 gallons per year.

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. The permittee shall collect and record the following information each day:
 - a. the company identification of each coating;
 - b. the number of gallons of each coating employed; and
 - c. the VOC content in pounds of VOC per gallon of each coating (including water), as applied.

D. Reporting Requirements

1. The permittee shall notify the Director of any daily record showing that the coating line exceeded the coating usage limits and/or the allowable VOC content limit. A copy of such record shall be sent to the Director within 45 days after the exceedance occurs.
2. The permittee shall submit a report to the Director which gives the total number of gallons of coating(s) employed in this emissions unit for the calendar year. This report shall be submitted by February 15th each year.

E. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with the emission limits in section A.1. of these T&Cs shall be demonstrated by the recordkeeping requirements in section C.1. of these T&Cs.
2. Compliance with the VOC coating content limits in section A.2.2.a. of these T&Cs shall be demonstrated by USEPA Methods 24.

If, pursuant to section 4.3 of Method 24, 40 CFR Part 60, Appendix A, an owner or operator determines that Method 24 cannot be used for a particular coating, the permittee shall so notify the Administrator of the USEPA and shall use formulation data for that coating to demonstrate compliance until the USEPA provides alternative analytical procedures or alternative precision statements for Method 24.
3. Compliance with the coating usage limits in section B.1. of these T&Cs shall be demonstrated by the recordkeeping requirements in section C.1. of these T&Cs.
