This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. 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**Part II - Special Terms and Conditions**

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

1. For the purpose of a permit-to-install document, the emissions unit terms and conditions identified below are federally enforceable with the exception of those listed below which are enforceable under state law only.

**A. Applicable Emissions Limitations and/or Control Requirements**

1. The specific operation(s), property, and/or equipment which constitute this emissions unit are listed in the following table along with the applicable rules and/or requirements and with the applicable emissions limitations and/or control measures. Emissions from this unit shall not exceed the listed limitations, and the listed control measures shall be employed. Additional applicable emissions limitations and/or control measures (if any) may be specified in narrative form following the table.

2. **Additional Terms and Conditions**
  - (a) The OC contents of the solvents employed in the solvent wipe cleaning operation shall not exceed 13.5 lbs/gal of perchloroethylene and 7.0 lbs/gal of thinner.

**B. Operational Restrictions**

1. The amount of perchloroethylene employed for solvent wipe cleaning shall not exceed 25 gal/month and 300 gal/year.
2. The amount of thinner employed for solvent wipe shall not exceed 12.5 gal/month and 150 gal/year.
3. The permittee shall cover the solvent catch basin when not in use and store all solvent laden rags in a closed container.

**C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements**

1. This facility shall maintain monthly records which list the following information for the cleaning solvent employed in this emissions unit:
  - a. The company identification of the cleaning solvent;
  - b. The number of gallons employed; and
  - c. The OC content in lbs/gallon, excluding water.

**D. Reporting Requirements**

1. The permittee shall notify the Director of any monthly record showing any exceedance of the usage and emission limitations as outlined. Also the report shall indicate the reason for the exceedance and the steps taken to resolve the violation. A copy of such record shall be sent to the Director within 45 days after the exceedance occurs.

**E. Testing Requirements**

1. Compliance with the OC emission limits in section A.1. and the solvent usage limits in section B.1. and B.2. of these T&Cs shall be demonstrated by the recordkeeping requirements of section C.1. of these T&Cs.
2. Compliance with the OC solvent content limits in section A.2.2.a. of these T&Cs shall be demonstrated by the recordkeeping requirements of section C.1. of these T&Cs and USEPA method 24 or formulation data provided by the solvent manufacturer.
