This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. **Part II - Special Terms and Conditions**

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

**B. Operational Restrictions**

1. This emissions unit shall operate no more than 50 weeks per year.
2. The total maximum usage of coatings and inks in all flexographic, packaging rotogravure and publication rotogravure printing lines located at this facility shall not exceed 148 tons per year.

**C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements**

1. This facility shall maintain daily records which list the following information:
  - a. the company name and identification of each surface coating, ink or clean-up material employed;
  - b. the number of gallons of each surface coating, ink or clean-up material employed;
  - c. the total number of gallons of all surface coatings and inks employed;
  - d. the VOC content of each surface coating, ink or clean-up material employed, in pounds of VOC per gallon;
  - e. the ammonia content of each surface coating, ink or clean-up material employed, in pounds of ammonia per gallon;
  - f. the total VOC emissions from all surface coatings, inks and clean-up materials employed, i.e., the sum of (b) (d) for each surface coating, ink and clean-up material, in pounds of VOC; and
  - g. the total ammonia emissions from all surface coatings, inks and clean-up materials employed, i.e., the sum of (b)(e) for each surface coating, ink and clean-up material, in pounds of ammonia.

**D. Reporting Requirements**

1. The permittee shall notify the Director of any daily record showing that the emission limitations as outlined have been exceeded. A copy of such record shall be sent to the Director within 45 days after the exceedance occurs.

**E. Testing Requirements**

1. The VOC and ammonia content of each surface coating, ink or clean-up material shall be based on formulation data determined on an as applied basis.
2. Compliance with the emission limits in section A.1. of these T&Cs shall be demonstrated by the recordkeeping requirements of section C.1 of these T&Cs.
