This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. Part II - Special Terms and Conditions

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

B. Operational Restrictions

1. Annual hours of operation for this emissions unit shall not exceed 1000 hours per calendar year.

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. Clermont County Sewer District shall maintain monthly records that list the hours of operation for this emissions unit. These records need only be kept when the source is in operation. Along with the individual monthly total of hours of operation, this facility shall maintain a running annual total of hours of operation for this emissions unit.

D. Reporting Requirements

1. The permittee shall notify the Director of any record showing that the hours of operation limitation has been exceeded. The report shall include the reason for the exceedance and the action taken to resolve the violation. A copy of such record shall be sent to the Director within 45 days after the exceedance occurs.

E. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with the emission limitation(s) in Section A.1. of these terms and conditions shall be determined in accordance with the following method(s):
 - a. Compliance with the OAC 3745-17-07(A) shall be demonstrated by OAC 3745-17-03(B)(1).
 - b. Compliance with the operating limitation shall be demonstrated by T&C C.1.
 - c. Compliance with the emission limitations shall be demonstrated by emission factors from AP-42(External Combustion Sources).

F. Miscellaneous Requirements
