This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. 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**Part II - Special Terms and Conditions**

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

**2. Additional Terms and Conditions**

- (a) The permittee shall equip this storage tank with a permanent submerged fill pipe and a conservation vent.  
This emission unit currently stores non-photochemically reactive materials as defined in OAC rule 3745-21-01(C)(5). Prior to storing photochemically reactive material in this emissions unit, the permittee shall provide written notification to the appropriate Ohio EPA District Office or local air agency. Such notification shall include information sufficient to determine compliance with the emission limits and/or control requirements spelled out in OAC rule 3745-21-07(D)(2). This notification, at a minimum, shall include the company identification of the new material to be stored, the solvent composition of the material, and the maximum amount to be used, in pounds per hour, and pounds per day.

**B. Operational Restrictions**

**C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements**

1. The permittee shall keep readily accessible records showing the dimension of the storage vessel and an analysis showing the capacity of the storage vessel. This information shall be kept for the life of the emissions unit.

**D. Reporting Requirements**

1. Prior to storing any material (inorganic or organic) or change in material stored in this emissions unit, the permittee shall provide written notification to the appropriate Ohio EPA District Office or local air agency. This notification shall include information sufficient to determine that the proposed change in materials will comply with all applicable Ohio EPA rules.

**E. Testing Requirements**

1. Compliance with the OC emission limit in section A.1 of this permit shall be determined by using emission estimation procedures outlined in AP-42, section 12.3.

**F. Miscellaneous Requirements**

1. The following terms and conditions shall supersede all the air pollution control requirements for this emissions unit contained in permit to install number 14-4191 as issued on 12-5-96:
