This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. **Part II - Special Terms and Conditions**

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

1. For the purpose of a permit-to-install document, the emissions unit terms and conditions identified below are federally enforceable with the exception of those listed below which are enforceable under state law only.

**A. Applicable Emissions Limitations and/or Control Requirements**

1. The specific operation(s), property, and/or equipment which constitute this emissions unit are listed in the following table along with the applicable rules and/or requirements and with the applicable emissions limitations and/or control measures. Emissions from this unit shall not exceed the listed limitations, and the listed control measures shall be employed. 2. **Additional Terms and Conditions**
  - (a) Visible fugitive particulate emissions shall not exceed 20 percent opacity, as a three-minute average, except as specified by rule.

**B. Operational Restrictions**

1. The drop height of the telescopic tube shall be minimized to the extent possible in order to minimize or eliminate visible particulate emissions of fugitive dust during sawdust unloading.
2. The maximum amount of sawdust unloaded shall not exceed 4000 cubic yards per year.

**C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements**

1. The permittee shall maintain monthly records of the amount of sawdust unloaded.

**D. Reporting Requirements**

1. The permittee shall submit annual reports that specify the total PM emissions for the previous calendar year. Emissions shall be calculated as follows: (amount of sawdust collected the previous year x 0.15 x 2) / 2000. These reports shall be submitted by January 31 of each year for the previous calendar year.
2. The permittee shall submit annual reports that identify the annual sawdust unloaded, in cubic yards. These reports shall be submitted by January 31 of each year for the preceding calendar year.

**E. Testing Requirements**

1. Compliance with the PM/PM10 emission limitations in these terms and conditions shall be determined by the emission calculations used to prepare PTI 14-4693.
2. Compliance with the visible fugitive particulate emission limitation shall be determined by the method specified in OAC rule 3745-17-03(B)(3).
3. Compliance with the amount of sawdust unloaded limit in T&C B.2 shall be determined by the required record keeping in T&C C.1.
