

ADDITIONAL SPECIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

A. Operational Restrictions

1. The maximum daily coating usage for this emissions unit shall not exceed 8 gallons.
2. The maximum weekly cleanup usage for this emissions unit shall not exceed 2.5 gallons.

B. Monitoring and Recordkeeping Requirements

1. The permittee shall collect and record the following information each month for the emissions unit:
 - a. The name and identification number of each coating employed.
 - b. The volume, in gallons, of each coating employed.
 - c. The total volume, in gallons, of all of the coatings employed.
 - d. The number of days the emissions unit was in operation.
 - e. The total volume, in gallons, of all of the coatings employed per day (average), i.e., (c)/(d).
2. The permittee shall collect and record the following information for the purpose of determining annual VOC emissions:
 - a. The name and identification of each cleanup material employed.
 - b. The number of gallons of each cleanup material employed.
 - c. The VOC content of each cleanup material, in pounds per gallon.
 - d. The VOC content of each coating, as applied, in pounds per gallon.
 - e. The total VOC emissions from all coatings and cleanup materials employed, in pounds or tons.
3. Each record of any monitoring data, testing data, and support information required pursuant to this permit shall be retained for a period of five years

from the date the record was created. Support information shall include, but not be limited to, all calibration and maintenance records and all original strip-chart recordings for continuous monitoring instrumentation, and copies of all reports required by the permit. Such records may be maintained in computerized form.

C. Reporting Requirements

1. The permittee shall notify the Director (the appropriate Ohio EPA District Office or local air agency) in writing of any daily record showing that the coating line employs more than the applicable maximum daily coating usage limit. The notification shall include a copy of such record and shall be sent to the Director (the appropriate Ohio EPA District Office or local air agency) within 45 days after the exceedance occurs.

D. Compliance Methodologies

1. Compliance with the emission limitation(s) in this permit shall be determined in accordance with the following method(s):

- a. Emission Limitation-
52.8 lbs VOC/day, excluding cleanup

Applicable Compliance Method-

Compliance shall be based on the maximum daily coating usage of 8 gallons times the maximum VOC content of any coating employed in this emissions unit. Compliance can also be based on the record keeping requirements specified in T&C No. B.1.

- b. Emission Limitation-
7.02 TPY VOC, including cleanup

Applicable Compliance Method-

Compliance shall be based on the record keeping requirements specified in T&C No. B.1. and B.2.

- c. Emission Limitation-
8 gallons coating/day

Applicable Compliance Method-

Compliance shall be based on the record keeping requirements specified in T&C No. B.1.
