This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. 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Part II - Special Terms and Conditions

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

1. For the purpose of a permit-to-install document, the emissions unit terms and conditions identified below are federally enforceable with the exception of those listed below which are enforceable under state law only.

A. Applicable Emissions Limitations and/or Control Requirements

1. B. Operational Restrictions

1. The permittee shall not employ a coating with a VOC content greater than 6.6 lbs of VOC/gallon, excluding water and exempt solvents.
2. The permittee shall not employ more than 126 gallons of coating per year.

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. The permittee shall collect and record the following information each day for the line:
 - a. The name and identification number of each coating and cleanup material, as applied.
 - b. The VOC content of each coating (excluding water and exempt solvents) and cleanup material, as applied.
 - c. Hours of operation.
 - d. The number of gallons (excluding water and exempt solvents) of each coating and cleanup material employed.
 - e. The total VOC emissions from all coatings and cleanup materials employed, in pounds or tons.
 - f. The calculated hourly emission rate, in pounds, i.e., e/c.

D. Reporting Requirements

1. The permittee shall notify the Director (the appropriate Ohio EPA District Office or local air agency) in writing of any daily record showing the use of noncomplying coatings (for lbs VOC/hr and/or lbs VOC/gallon). The notification shall include a copy of such record and shall be sent to the Director (the appropriate Ohio EPA District Office or local air agency) within 30 days following the date of occurrence.
2. The permittee shall submit annual reports which specify the total VOC emissions from this emissions unit for the previous calendar year. These reports shall be submitted by January 31 of each year.

E. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with the emission limitation(s) in Section A.I. of these terms and conditions shall be determined in accordance with the following method(s):
Emission limitation: 4.9 lbs VOC/hr and 0.8 ton VOC/yr

Applicable Compliance Method: Compliance of hourly VOC limitation is by the record keeping specified in

Section C of these terms and conditions. Yearly VOC emissions is determined by the sum of the daily emissions for the calendar year.

Emission limitation: 6.6 lbs of VOC/gallon, excluding water and exempt solvents.

Applicable Compliance Method:OAC rule 3745-21-10(B). USEPA Methods 24 and 24A shall be used to determine the VOC contents for (a) coatings and (b) flexographic and rotogravure printing inks and related coatings, respectively. If, pursuant to section 4.3 of Method 24, 40 CFR Part 60, Appendix A, an owner or operator determines that Method 24 or 24A cannot be used for a particular coating or ink, the permittee shall so notify the Administrator of the USEPA and shall use formulation data for that coating or ink to demonstrate compliance until the USEPA provides alternative analytical procedures or alternative precision statements for Method 24 or 24A.

Emission limitation: The permittee shall not employ more than 126 gallons of coating per year.

Applicable Compliance Method:Use of the records required by section C of these terms and conditions.
