This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. Part II - Special Terms and Conditions

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

B. Operational Restrictions

1. The annual throughput of corn gluten shall not exceed 400,000 tons per year.

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. The permittee shall maintain daily records of the throughput of corn gluten for this emissions unit.

D. Reporting Requirements

1. The permittee shall submit deviation (excursion) reports which document all exceedances of the usage limitation as outlined in this permit. The notification shall include a copy of such record and shall be sent to the Director (the appropriate Ohio EPA District Office or local air agency) within 45 days after the exceedance occurs.

E. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with the visible emissions limitations shall be determined by methods specified in the OAC 3745-17-03(B).
2. Compliance with the emission limitations outlined in this permit shall be demonstrated by the emission factors, control efficiencies and the operational parameters in PTI application 14-1731 as submitted 12/12/90.
3. Compliance with the usage limitations shall be demonstrated by the record keeping in C.

F. Miscellaneous Requirements

1. The following terms and conditions shall supersede all the air pollution control requirements for this emissions unit contained in the permit to install 14-1731 as issued on 12/12/90: A-E.
