This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. 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**Part II - Special Terms and Conditions**

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

**B. Operational Restrictions**

1. The maximum weekly solvent base glue usage for this emissions unit shall not exceed 24 Gallons.
2. The maximum annual solvent base glue usage for this emissions unit shall not exceed 1248 Gallons
3. The use of photochemically reactive materials as defined in OAC rule 3745-21-01(C)(5) is prohibited in this emissions unit.

**C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements**

1. The permittee shall maintain weekly records of the following:
  - a. the company identification of each type of glue used in this emission unit,
  - b. the OC content of each glue used in this emissions unit, and
  - c. the amount of glue (in gallons) used in this emissions unit.

These weekly records, as well as any supporting analyses and computations, shall be retained in the company's files for a period of not less than three years from the date the record was created and shall be made available to the Director for review during normal business hours. The records may be maintained in computerized form.

**D. Reporting Requirements**

1. The permittee shall notify the Director of any exceedance of the emissions and usage limitations as outlined in this permit. A copy of such record shall be sent to the Director within 45 days after the exceedance occurs.

**E. Testing Requirements**

1. Compliance with the emission limits in section A.1. of these T&Cs shall be demonstrated by the recordkeeping requirements of section C.1. of these T&Cs.
2. Compliance with the glue usage limits in section B.1. of these T&Cs shall be demonstrated by the recordkeeping requirements of section C.1. of these T&Cs.
3. Compliance with the OC content limits in section A.1. of these T&Cs shall be demonstrated by the glue formulation data provided by the glue manufacturer.

**F. Miscellaneous Requirements**

1. If probable cause exists indicating the emissions unit is causing or contributing to a nuisance in violation of Ohio Administrative Code 3745-15-07, the owner or operator of this emissions unit shall be required to submit and implement a control program which will bring this emissions unit into compliance.
