This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

2. **Additional Terms and Conditions**
  - (a) There shall be no visible particulate emissions from this emissions unit at any time.

**B. Operational Restrictions**

1. The permittee shall comply with the following waste disposal requirements:
  - a. All asbestos-containing waste material shall be wetted and sealed in leak-tight containers while wet.
  - b. All containers shall be labeled using warning labels specified by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) under 29 CFR 1910.1001(j)(2) or 1926.58(k)(2)(iii) and the Department of Transportation under 49 CFR 100-199. The labels shall be printed in letters of sufficient size and contrast so as to be readily visible and legible.
  - c. All asbestos-containing waste material shall be deposited as soon as is practical by the waste generator at a waste disposal site operated in accordance with the provisions of 40 CFR 61.154.
  - d. All asbestos-containing waste material transported off the facility site shall be labeled with the name of the waste generator and the location at which the waste was generated.
  - e. All vehicles used to transport asbestos-containing waste shall be marked during the loading and unloading of the waste in accordance with 40 CFR 61.149(d)(1)(i), (ii), and (iii).
  - f. The permittee shall complete and maintain waste shipment records in accordance with 40 CFR 61.150(d) for all asbestos-containing waste material transported off the facility site.
2. The permittee shall employ a suction around and in the opening of the cylinder with a HEPA filtered vacuum at all times during operation.

**E. Testing Requirements**

1. Emissions Limitation: No visible particulate emissions from this emissions unit at any time.

Applicable Compliance Method: Compliance with the visible particulate emission limitation shall be determined by Method 22 as set forth in the "Appendix on Test Methods" in 40 CFR, Part 60, "Standards of Performance for New Stationary Sources: as such appendix existed on July 1, 1996, and as outlined in OAC rule 3745-17-03 (B) (3).
