This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. 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**Part II - Special Terms and Conditions**

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

**B. Operational Restrictions**

1. This emissions unit shall not operate more than 250 days per year.

**C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements**

1. This facility shall maintain daily records which include the following information:
  - a. the company identification of each coating and cleanup material employed;
  - b. the number of gallons of each coating employed, as applied;
  - c. the number of gallons of each cleanup material employed;
  - d. the OC content of each coating employed, in pounds per gallon, as applied;
  - e. the OC content of each cleanup material employed, in pounds per gallon;
  - f. the daily OC emissions from all coatings and cleanup materials, in pounds, i.e., the sum of (C.1.b)x(C.1.d) plus (C.1.c)x(C.1.e) for each coating and cleanup material identified in C.1.a;
  - g. the hours of operation; and
  - h. the average hourly OC emission rate, i.e., (C.1.f)/(C.1.g).

**D. Reporting Requirements**

1. The permittee shall notify the Hamilton County Department of Environmental Services in writing of any daily record showing an exceedance of any emission limitation required by this permit. The notification shall include a copy of such record and shall be sent to the Hamilton County Department of Environmental Services within 45 days after the exceedance occurs.

**E. Testing Requirements**

1. Formulation data or USEPA Method 24 shall be used to determine the OC contents of inks and coatings.
2. Compliance with the emission limitations shall be demonstrated through the record keeping and reporting requirements of sections C.1 and D.1 of this permit.
