Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. 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Part II - Special Terms and Conditions

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

2. Additional Terms and Conditions

- (a) Pursuant to OAC rule 3745-17-07(B)(1), visible particulate emissions from this emissions unit shall not exceed twenty percent opacity as a three-minute average. Pursuant to OAC rule 3745-17-08(B)(3), equipment shall be adequately enclosed to minimize or eliminate visible particulate emissions.

B. Operational Restrictions

1. This emission unit shall be limited to three (3) batches per day.

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. This facility shall maintain daily records of the number of batches processed.

D. Reporting Requirements

1. The permittee shall notify the Director of any daily record showing that the emissions unit as outlined in this permit exceeds the batches per day limitations as outlined. A copy of such record shall be sent to the Director within 45 days after the exceedance occurs.

E. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with the emission limitation(s) in Section A.I. of these terms and conditions shall be determined in accordance with the following method(s):
 - i. Compliance with the visible particulate emission limitation shall be demonstrated by the method outlined in OAC 3745-17-03(B)(3).
 - ii. Compliance with the particulate emission limitations shall be demonstrated by multiplying the amount of non-liquid materials introduced into this process by the factor of 1%. This factor was furnished by the facility and was used to establish the allowable particulate emission limitation.
