This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. 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Part II - Special Terms and Conditions

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

B. Operational Restrictions

1. The total amount of concrete produced by this emissions unit shall not exceed 250,000 TPY.

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. This facility shall maintain monthly records which indicate the total amount of concrete produced by this emissions unit.

D. Reporting Requirements

1. This facility shall submit to the Hamilton County Department of Environmental Services an annual report which summarizes the total amount of concrete produced by this emissions unit. This report shall be submitted by February 15 of each year and shall cover the previous 12 calendar months (January through December).
2. The permittee shall submit a "Notice of Intent to Relocate a Portable or Mobile Source" form 30 days prior to any planned relocation of this emissions unit, in accordance with OAC rule 3745-31-03(A)(1)(p). Approval of the planned relocation must be obtained from the Hamilton County Department of Environmental Services prior to relocation.

E. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with OAC 3745-17-07(B) shall be demonstrated by methods outlined in OAC 3745-17-03(B)(3).
2. Compliance with the production limitation shall be demonstrated by recordkeeping requirement described in section C.

F. Miscellaneous Requirements
