This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. The permittee shall collect and record the following information each month for all flexographic presses at the facility:
 - a. The name and identification number of each coating and ink employed.
 - b. The VOC content of each coating and ink (excluding water and exempt solvents), as applied.
 - c. The number of gallons of each coating and ink employed.
 - d. The density of each coating and ink, in pounds per gallon.
 - e. The total weight of all coatings and inks employed, in tons.

D. Reporting Requirements

1. The permittee shall submit annual reports to the Hamilton County Department of Environmental Services that summarize the total weight, in tons, of all inks and coatings employed in all flexographic presses located at this facility. The reports shall be submitted by February 15 of each year and shall cover the previous twelve calendar months (January through December).

E. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with the limitation outlined in this permit shall be demonstrated by the record keeping required in term C.
