This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. Finally, the term language under "Part II" and before "A. Applicable Emissions Limitations..." has been added to aid in document conversion, and was not part of the original issued permit.

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Part II - Special Terms and Conditions

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

1. For the purpose of a permit-to-install document, the emissions unit terms and conditions identified below are federally enforceable with the exception of those listed below which are enforceable under state law only.

A. Applicable Emissions Limitations and/or Control Requirements

1. The specific operation(s), property, and/or equipment which constitute this emissions unit are listed in the following table along with the applicable rules and/or requirements and with the applicable emissions limitations and/or control measures. Emissions from this unit shall not exceed the listed limitations, and the listed control measures shall be employed. Additional applicable emissions limitations and/or control measures (if any) may be specified in narrative form following the table.

2. Additional Terms and Conditions

- (a) As provided by OAC rule 3745-21-09(K)(2), this emission limit does not apply to quick-drying lacquers for the repair of scratches and nicks that occur during assembly, provided that the maximum usage of such lacquers does not exceed one quart in any eight-hour period.
As provided by OAC rule 3745-21-09(K)(4), this emission limit does not apply to large appliance coatings that are subject to in-use temperatures in excess of 250 degrees Fahrenheit.

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. The permittee shall collect and record the following information each month for the line:
 - a. The name and identification number of each coating, as applied.
 - b. The VOC content of each coating (excluding water and exempt solvents), as applied. (This includes any coating subject to the VOC content limit under Section A.1 and any coating subject to an exemption under Section A.2.)
 - c. For quick-drying lacquers subject to the exemption under Section A.2.a, the combined usage of such lacquers in quarts (or liquid ounces) for each eight-hour period.
 - d. For any coating subject to the exemption under section A.2.b, documentation on the maximum in-use temperature of that coating.

D. Reporting Requirements

1. The permittee shall notify the Director (the appropriate Ohio EPA District Office or local air agency) in writing of any monthly record showing the use of noncomplying coatings. The notification shall include a copy of such record and shall be sent to the Director (the appropriate Ohio EPA District Office or local air agency) within 30 days following the end of the calendar month. The following are noncomplying coatings that are to be reported:
 - a. Any coating which is not subject to an exemption under Section A.2 and which has a VOC content exceeding the limit specified in Section A.1.
 - b. Any quick-drying lacquers which have a combined usage that exceeded 1 quart during any 8-hour period.
 - c. Any coating which is subject to the high temperature exemption under Section A.2.b and which has a maximum in-use temperature not exceeding 250 degrees Fahrenheit.

E. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with the emission limitation in Section A.1. of these terms and conditions shall be determined in accordance with the following method(s):

Emission Limitation:

2.8 pounds VOC per gallon of coating, excluding water and exempt solvents.

Applicable Compliance Method: Compliance shall be based upon the record keeping requirements specified in Section C. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-21-04(B)(5), USEPA Method 24 shall be used to determine the VOC contents of the coatings. If, pursuant to section 4.3 of Method 24, 40 CFR Part 60, Appendix A, an owner or operator determines that Method 24 cannot be used for a particular coating, the permittee shall so notify the Administrator of the USEPA and shall use formulation data for that coating to demonstrate compliance until the USEPA provides alternative analytical procedures or alternative precision statements for Method 24.
