This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. Part II - Special Terms and Conditions

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

1. 2. **Additional Terms and Conditions**
 - (a) Visible particulate emissions from any stack shall not exceed 20% opacity, as a six-minute average, except as specified by rule.
The hourly PE and OC emission limitations outlined above are based on the emissions unit's potential to emit. Therefore, no hourly records are required to determine compliance with these limits.

B. Operational Restrictions

1. This emissions unit shall not be operated without the concurrent operation of the control device.

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

E. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with the visible emissions limitation shall be determined by visible emission evaluations performed in accordance with OAC rule 3745-17-03(B)(1) using the methods and procedures specified in USEPA Reference Method 9.
2. Compliance with the hourly PE and OC emission limitations outlined in this permit shall be determined by the emission factors, control efficiencies, and the operational parameters as submitted in the PTI application submitted on 11/06/91 for this emissions unit.
3. Compliance with the annual OC and PE emission limitations will be shown as long as compliance with the hourly OC and PE emission limitations is maintained (the annual OC and PE emission limitations were calculated by multiplying the maximum hourly OC and PE emission limitations (0.08 lb/hr and 0.083 lb/hr, respectively) by 8,760 hours and dividing by 2,000).

F. Miscellaneous Requirements

1. If probable cause exists indicating the emissions unit is causing or contributing to a nuisance in violation of OAC rule 3745-15-07, the permittee shall submit and implement a control program that will bring this emissions unit into compliance.
