This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. 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Part II - Special Terms and Conditions

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

1. For the purpose of a permit-to-install document, the emissions unit terms and conditions identified below are federally enforceable with the exception of those listed below which are enforceable under state law only.

A. Applicable Emissions Limitations and/or Control Requirements

1. The specific operation(s), property, and/or equipment which constitute this emissions unit are listed in the following table along with the applicable rules and/or requirements and with the applicable emissions limitations and/or control measures. Emissions from this unit shall not exceed the listed limitations, and the listed control measures shall be employed. 2. **Additional Terms and Conditions**
 - (a) The hourly OC emission limit is based on the liquid organic material with the highest OC content and the maximum material usage rate of the equipment; therefore, compliance with hourly OC emission limit is assumed.

The annual OC emission limit is based on the liquid organic material with the highest OC content and the annual material usage. Therefore, compliance with the annual material usage limit shall constitute compliance with the annual OC emission limit.

B. Operational Restrictions

1. The permittee shall not operate this emissions unit for more than 4000 hrs/yr.
2. The permittee shall not employ more than 103 gallons/month and 1230 gallons/yr of liquid organic material in this emissions unit. The annual usage limit is based on a rolling, 12-month summation.

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. The permittee shall maintain monthly records of the following:
 - a. The name and identification of each liquid organic material employed.
 - b. The total number of gallons of all liquid organic materials employed.
 - c. The rolling, 12-month total number of gallons of all liquid organic materials employed.

D. Reporting Requirements

1. The permittee shall notify the Director in writing of any monthly record which shows an exceedance of the rolling, 12-month usage limit. A copy of each such record shall be submitted within 30 days of the exceedance.

E. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with the annual material usage limit shall be demonstrated by the record keeping requirements in section C.1. of this permit.

F. Miscellaneous Requirements

1. The following terms and conditions shall supersede all of the air pollution control requirements for this emissions unit contained in permit to install number 14-1569 as issued on 7-20-88:
