This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. **Part II - Special Terms and Conditions**

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

**B. Operational Restrictions**

1. The maximum annual storage of sand and aggregate materials in the concrete batch plant shall not exceed 64,370 tons per year.
2. During the loading of the sand and aggregate onto the conveyor, the drop height of the front-end loaders shall be minimized in order to minimize or eliminate the visible emissions of fugitive dust.

**C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements**

1. This facility shall maintain monthly records of the amount of sand and aggregate stored, in tons.

**D. Reporting Requirements**

1. This facility shall notify the Hamilton County Department of Environmental Services in writing of any monthly record which shows an exceedance of the usage limitations in section B. of this permit. The report shall include a copy of each such record and shall be submitted within 30 days of the exceedance.

**E. Testing Requirements**

1. Compliance with OAC rule 3745-17-07(B)(6) shall be demonstrated by the test method and procedures specified in OAC rule 3745-17-03(B)(4).
2. Compliance with the usage limitations shall be demonstrated by record keeping requirement in section C.1. of this permit.
3. Compliance with the annual particulate emissions limit shall be demonstrated by use of the emission factors in AP-42 11.2.3 and RACM.

**F. Miscellaneous Requirements**

1. The following terms and conditions shall supersede all the air pollution control requirements for this emissions unit contained in permit to install number 14-4170 as issued on 9-5-96:
