This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. Part II - Special Terms and Conditions

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

A. Applicable Emissions Limitations and/or Control Requirements

1. 2. Additional Terms and Conditions

- (a) There shall be no visible emissions from the stack serving this emission unit with compliance to be determined using Test Method 22 as defined in OAC 3745-17-03 (B) (4). The permittee shall utilize a High Volume Low Pressure (HVLP) spray gun to apply coatings in this emission unit. The permittee shall utilize exhaust filters to serve this emission unit and such filters shall be changed at a frequency to ensure compliance with the visible emission limitation.

B. Operational Restrictions

1. Pursuant to PTI # 15-1079 and Modification, the permittee shall be limited to using no more than twenty (20) gallons of coating per month in this emission unit.

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. The permittee shall collect and record the following information each month for the line:
 - (a) The name and identification number of each coating, as applied.
 - (b) The VOC content of each coating (excluding water and exempt solvents), as applied.
 - (c) The number of gallons (excluding water and exempt solvents) of each coating employed.
 - (d) The name and identification of each cleanup material employed.
 - (e) The VOC content of each cleanup material, in pounds per gallon.
 - (f) The number of gallons of each cleanup material employed.
 - (g) The total OC emissions from all coatings and cleanup materials employed, in pounds or tons per month.
 - (h) The date(s) of filter replacement.
The permittee shall maintain monthly records of the coating usage in this emissions unit.

D. Reporting Requirements

1. The permittee shall notify the Director of any monthly record showing the use of noncomplying coatings. A copy of such record shall be sent to the Director within 30 days following the end of the calendar month. The permittee shall submit annual reports which identify any exceedances of the monthly coating usage

limitation, as well as the corrective actions that were taken to achieve compliance. These reports shall be submitted by January 31 of each year.
