Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. 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Part II - Special Terms and Conditions

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

- (a) The permittee shall not allow the organic material and/or styrene emissions from this emissions unit to exceed 0.33 pound per hour. This emissions unit shall be equipped and operated in a manner which minimizes monomer or organic material evaporation. This emissions unit shall be maintained regularly in accordance with good engineering practices and the recommendations of the manufacturer in order to minimize air contaminant emissions.
