However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. Emissions of volatile organic compounds shall not exceed 4.76 pounds per hour

The hourly VOC emission rate was established in a PTI and is greater than the Potential to emit for this emissions unit. The calculated potential to emit for this emissions unit when filling the worst case product is 0.32 pounds per hour.

Emissions of volatile organic compounds shall not exceed 1.84 pounds per hour

Applicable Compliance Method:

The hourly VOC emission rate was established in a PTI and is greater than the Potential to emit for this emissions unit. The calculated potential to emit for this emissions unit when filling the worst case product is 0.22 pounds per hour.
