This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. 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Part II - Special Terms and Conditions

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

B. Operational Restrictions

1. The permittee shall not operate this emissions unit for more than 1143 hours per year.

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. The permittee shall record and calculate the following information on a monthly basis for this emissions unit:
 - a. number of hours of operation;
 - b. throughput of material, in pounds; and
 - c. the average particulate emissions, in pounds per hour.

D. Reporting Requirements

1. The permittee shall submit deviation (excursion) reports which identify any period of time that the average hourly particulate emissions exceeds the allowable mass emissions rate.

E. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with the emission limitations in Section A.1 of these terms and conditions shall be determined in accordance with the following methods:
Emission Limitation:
3.5 lbs/hr of particulate emissions
Applicable Compliance Method:
Multiply the particulate emission factor of 2.0 pounds per ton of material processed by the maximum production rate.
The emission factor was developed by the Akron RAQMD based upon best engineering judgement.
Emission Limitation:
20% opacity as a 6-minute average
Applicable Compliance Method:

OAC rule 3745-17-03(B)(1)

F. **Miscellaneous Requirements**

1. The following terms and conditions shall supersede all the air pollution control requirements for this emissions unit contained in permit to install 16-1267, as issued on May 12, 1993: A, B, C, D and E.
