This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. 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Part II - Special Terms and Conditions

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

B. Operational Restrictions

1. The permittee shall employ no more than three gallons of coatings in any one day in this emissions unit.

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. The permittee shall collect and record the following information each day for the coating line:
 - a. The name and identification number of each coating and cleanup material employed.
 - b. The VOC content of each coating, as applied, in pounds per gallon.
 - c. The VOC content of each cleanup material, in pounds per gallon.
 - d. The volume of each coating, as applied, in gallons.
 - e. The total volume of all coatings, as applied, in gallons.
 - f. The volume of each cleanup material, in gallons.
 - g. The total VOC emissions from all coatings, as applied, and cleanup materials, in pounds, i.e., (sum of [b x d] for all coatings) + sum of [c x f] for all cleanup materials).

[Note: For the purposes of this section, formulation data may be used to determine the VOC content of each coating, after any final thinning by the permittee, and each cleanup material.]

2. From the daily VOC emissions recorded in C.1.g above, the permittee shall determine and record each calendar year the annual VOC emissions from this emissions unit, in tons.

D. Reporting Requirements

1. The permittee shall submit deviation (excursion) reports which identify each calendar year during which the annual VOC emissions from this emissions unit exceeded 0.58 ton. The annual VOC emissions exceedance report shall be submitted to the Director (the appropriate Ohio EPA District Office or local air agency) by January 31 of each year.
2. The permittee shall notify the Director (the appropriate Ohio EPA District Office or local air agency) in writing of any daily record showing that the coating line employs more than the applicable maximum daily coating usage limit. The notification shall include a copy of such record and shall be sent to the Director (the appropriate Ohio EPA District Office or local air agency) within 45 days after the exceedance occurs.

3. The deviation reports shall be submitted in accordance with the requirements specified in Part I - General Term and Condition 3 of this permit.

E. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with the emission limitation in Section A.1 of these terms and conditions shall be determined in accordance with the following method:
Emission Limitation: 0.58 ton/yr of VOCs

Applicable Compliance Method: Compliance shall be based upon the record keeping requirements specified in Section C.
