This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. 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Part II - Special Terms and Conditions

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

1. For the purpose of a permit-to-install document, the emissions unit terms and conditions identified below are federally enforceable with the exception of those listed below which are enforceable under state law only.

2. For the purpose of a permit-to-operate document, the emissions unit terms and conditions identified below are enforceable under state law only with the exception of those listed below which are federally enforceable.

A. Applicable Emissions Limitations and/or Control Requirements

1. The specific operation(s), property, and/or equipment which constitute this emissions unit are listed in the following table along with the applicable rules and/or requirements and with the applicable emissions limitations and/or control measures. Emissions from this unit shall not exceed the listed limitations, and the listed control measures shall be employed. Additional applicable emissions limitations and/or control measures (if any) may be specified in narrative form following the table.

2. Additional Terms and Conditions

- (a) The 5 pounds VOC/hour emission limitation was established to verify compliance with the Ohio EPA Air Toxics Policy. Therefore, no record keeping and/or reporting requirements are necessary to ensure compliance with this limit. The maximum VOC coating content shall not exceed 7.3 pounds VOC/gallon excluding water and exempt solvents.

B. Operational Restrictions

1. The maximum monthly coating usage for this emissions unit shall not exceed 25.4 gallons.
2. The maximum hourly coating usage shall not exceed 0.68 gallon (excluding water and exempt solvents) per hour. Note: No record keeping and/or reporting requirements are necessary to ensure compliance with this limit since the calculations were based on the maximum potential to emit.

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. The permittee shall collect and record the following information each month for the line:
 - a. the name and identification number of each coating, as applied;
 - b. the VOC content of each coating (excluding water and exempt solvents), as applied;
 - c. the total volume, in gallons (excluding water and exempt solvents) of all of the coatings employed;
 - d. the total VOC emissions from all coatings employed, in pounds or tons.

D. Reporting Requirements

1. The permittee shall submit annual reports which identify any exceedances of the monthly coating usage limitation, as well as the corrective actions that were taken to achieve compliance. These reports shall be submitted by January 31 of each year.
2. The permittee shall notify the Ohio EPA Central District Office in writing of any monthly record showing the use of noncomplying coatings (coatings with VOC content over 7.3 pounds VOC/gallon). The notification shall include a copy of such record and shall be sent to the Ohio EPA Central District Office within 30 days following the end of the calendar month.
3. The permittee shall also include in the annual report a quantification of the total VOC emissions from this emissions unit for the previous calendar year. These reports shall be submitted by January 31 of each year.

E. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with the emission limitation(s) in Section A.1. of these terms and conditions shall be determined in

accordance with the following method(s):

Emission Limitation:

5.0 pounds VOC/hour

Applicable Compliance Method:

Multiply the maximum hourly coating usage (0.68 gallon/hour) by the maximum VOC content (7.3 pounds VOC/gallon) of the coating.

Emission Limitation:

1.44 tons VOC/year

Applicable Compliance Method:

Compliance shall be determined by multiplying the total number of gallons used (gallons/year) of each coating by the VOC content of the coating (pounds VOC/gallon), adding the results for all coatings together, and dividing by 2000 pounds /ton.

VOC content shall be determined by using OAC rule 3745-21-10(B). Formulation data or USEPA Method 24 (for coatings) shall be used to determine the organic compound contents of the coatings.

F. Miscellaneous Requirements

1. The following terms and conditions shall supersede all the air pollution control requirements contained in permit to install #01-6656 issued for this emissions unit on July 30, 1996: A.1., A.2.a., A.2.b., B.1.,B.2.,B.3.,C.1., D.1, D.2, D.3, and E.1.
