This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. E. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with the visible particulate emission limit in section A.1. of these terms and conditions shall be determined in accordance with the test method and procedures in OAC rule 3745-17-03(B)(1).
2. Compliance with the NOx, CO, OC, VOC, and Methane emission limits in section A.1. of these terms and conditions shall be demonstrated by the use of emission factors found in US EPA publication titled Compilation of Air Pollutant Emission Factors AP-42, Table 3.2-2.

Emission factors:

NOx = 3.2 lbs/MMBtu of actual heat input
 CO = 0.42 lb/MMBtu of actual heat input
 OC = 1.2 lbs/MMBtu of actual heat input
 VOC = 0.18 lb/MMBtu of actual heat input
 Methane = 1.1 lbs/MMBtu of actual heat input

Multiply the 1.29 MMBtu/hr (max. input capacity) x emission factor = lbs/hr.

Multiply the lbs/hr x 8,760 hrs/yr, then divide by 2,000 lbs/ton = TPY.

3. Compliance with the mass emission limit for particulate matter in section A.1. of these terms and conditions shall be determined in accordance with the test method and procedures in OAC 3745-17-01(B)(11).

F. **Miscellaneous Requirements**

1. The following terms and conditions shall supersede all the air pollution control requirements for this emissions unit contained in permit to install number 17-1539 as issued on 4-2-97:
