This version of facility specific terms and conditions was converted from a database format to an HTML file during an upgrade of the Ohio EPA, Division of Air Pollution Control's permitting software. Every attempt has been made to convert the terms and conditions to look and substantively conform to the permit issued or being drafted in STARS. However, the format of the terms may vary slightly from the original. In addition, although it is not expected, there is a slight possibility that a term and condition may have been inadvertently "left out" of this reproduction during the conversion process. Therefore, if this version is to be used as a starting point in drafting a new version of a permit, it is imperative that the entire set of terms and conditions be reviewed to ensure they substantively mimic the issued permit. Part II - Special Terms and Conditions

This permit document constitutes a permit-to-install issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(F) and a permit-to-operate issued in accordance with ORC 3704.03(G).

B. Operational Restrictions

C. Monitoring and/or Record Keeping Requirements

1. The permittee shall maintain records which indicate the following information relative to the operation of this emissions unit:
 - a. the total daily and annual hours of operation of this emissions unit (i.e., the time during which this conveyORIZED hot air oven is actually used for the curing of extruded rubber products);
 - b. the total daily weight of rubber products processed in this emissions unit (in pounds); and
 - c. calculations, based on daily and annual processing data collected and recorded above, which indicate the following:
 - i. the hourly average pounds of rubber processed per day; and
 - ii. the daily hourly average and annual total VOC and sulfur compound emissions from this rubber curing oven.

D. Reporting Requirements

1. The permittee shall submit an annual report which summarizes the annual total VOC and sulfur compound emissions as calculated and recorded per the requirements of Section C. of these terms and conditions.

 This report shall be compiled and submitted to the Ohio EPA, Northeast District Office, by February 15 of each year and shall cover the operations of this emissions unit for the previous calendar year.

E. Testing Requirements

1. Compliance with the emissions limitations in Sections A.1. of these terms and conditions shall be determined in accordance with the following methods:
 Emissions Limitation: VOC emissions from this emissions unit shall not exceed 1.18 lbs/hr and 5.19 TPY.

 Applicable Compliance Method: Calculations based on a compilation of daily and annual operations and processing rate data recorded above and VOC emissions factors developed for this type of equipment by the Rubber Manufacturers Association, 1995 Emissions Study Report (copy on file at DAPC/NEDO).
 Emissions Limitation: Total sulfur compound emissions from this emissions unit shall not exceed 0.45 lbs/hr and 1.98 TPY.

Applicable Compliance Method: Calculations based on a compilation of daily and annual operations and processing rate data recorded above and total sulfur compound emissions factors developed for this type of equipment by the Rubber Manufacturers Association, 1995 Emissions Study Report (copy on file at DAPC/NEDO).
